SINGLE DAY REGISTRATION POLICY: Due to the high costs of field trips (Transportation, admission, staffing, etc.) registrations for the field trip days only will not be accepted UNLESS booked with another single day or more within the same week, which helps cover the costs of our program. Single day registrations are subject to availability and full-week registrations will be given priority. **LIMITED SPACE ~ Register early to avoid disappointment.**

CANCELLATION POLICY: Due to trip booking contracts, a minimum two-week notice is required for a full cancellation refund request. One-week notice will only be eligible for 50% refund and requests with less than one-week notice will not be eligible for a refund without a doctor's note. Cancellations refund requests for days within a full-week that has been registered will not be approved. **ALL REFUND REQUESTS ARE SUBJECT TO A \$10 ADMINISTRATION FEE; \$40 Administration Fee for NSF Cheques.**

- Due to high volume of registrations, families will only be contacted after a registration is received if there is an issue with the registration (i.e. camp full, missing info, etc.). - Families will receive a "Welcome to Camp" email from the Day Camp Supervisor, by the Friday night prior to camp starting on the Monday. This email will share more specific details of the upcoming camp week. **Please fill out your email address on the registration form.**
- Camp hours will operate from 9:00 am – 4:00 pm, with FREE before care from 8:00 am – 9:00 am and FREE after care from 4:00 pm – 5:00 pm. Some field trips may require an earlier drop-off time or later pick-up time.
- If your child will be absent, or late, please call the **Day Camp Supervisor 705-528-9000**
- If your child is not feeling well, please keep your child at home to ensure they receive adequate care. Our goal is to keep our campers active all day and a camper under the weather may not feel up to the daily activities that are planned and we are unable to provide 1 to 1 support. Children with head lice will not be permitted to attend camp until it has been treated and the hair is clear from eggs.
- **WHAT TO BRING:** Indoor shoes and a sweater, sunscreen, hat, a change of clothes, towel and bathing suit for the Splash Pad and weather-appropriate clothing for outdoors – Flip Flops are not recommended. Please keep in mind that some activities can get messy, so comfortable play clothing is best. (Please apply sunscreen on your child every day). Electronics, cell phones, toys and valuables should not be brought to camp and the Town will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- **FOOD:** Please be considerate of food allergies, therefore we kindly request nut-free snacks and lunch every day, and pack a re-fillable water bottle. One day each week, campers will be provided hot lunch (pizza/hotdog, etc.), as well as an ice-cream treat from the World Famous Dock Lunch. A schedule will be provided to parents on the first day of camp each week. Some crafts/activities may involve food/treats, so please ensure you fill out any food allergies on the registration form
- Your child's safety is our #1 priority! We have camp staff that are certified with Standard First Aid/CPR, HIGH-FIVE® Training and are trained by experienced leaders to ensure that we operate our camp in a safe manner.
- Staff will treat minor injuries (i.e. nose bleeds/blister), complete an Incident Report for the illness/injury, and will provide it to you for your perusal and signature at sign-out. You will receive a phone call from the Day Camp Supervisor for any moderate/major emergencies (i.e. vomiting, head injuries, etc.).
- Day trips will include all campers wearing the same uniformed shirt or wrist-band that will have "In Case of Emergency" phone number listed, and will be assigned a group leader and buddy system implemented to ensure that our youth are monitored carefully. If a child refuses to wear our field trip gear or fails to bring proper clothing and any required waiver forms, unfortunately they will not be permitted to attend the field trip. Please be on time on field trip days, as the bus cannot wait for late campers!
- Please note that field trips and programming are subject to last minute revisions, and local day trips may be added to the schedule that will require the children to walk or take School Bus transportation to the location.

TOWN OF PENETANGUISHENE - CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT

The Town of Penetanguishene Day Camp follows the **R.E.S.P.E.C.T model**. Please read through the following rules with your camper:

Recognize the rules and instructions for all games and activities

Encourage others and show good sportsmanship

Stay hands-free

Participate and have a positive attitude

Ensure a safe and clean environment

Care and be kind to one another

Take turns and play fair

- Staff will spend a portion of morning circle reviewing camp rules and expectations, asking campers for their input.
- If a camper struggles with following a rule, staff will have a one-on-one discussion with him/her to explain why the rule is in place.
- If the behaviour continues throughout the day, parents will be notified at sign out, and asked to review the rules with their camper at home.
- If the behaviour continues consistently throughout the week, a meeting with Day Camp Staff, the Camper, and Parent will be arranged, and a Behaviour Contract will be discussed and signed.
- If any camper becomes aggressive or physically violent, the Day Camp Supervisor will remove the camper from camp immediately and call the Parent/Guardian requesting that the camper be picked up and no refund will be granted. A meeting with the Day Camp Supervisor(s) and Recreation & Events Coordinator will follow to determine the next steps.
