



AQUATIC INSTRUCTOR/GUARD CONTRACT POSITION

The Town of Penetanguishene is a picturesque community with a population of approximately 9000 located on the southerly tip of beautiful Georgian Bay. We are now accepting Aquatic Instructor/Guard applications for positions beginning in Fall of 2018.

The Town offers swimming lessons for all ages at the Waypoint Atrium Building Pool. As an Aquatic Instructor/Guard, you will provide leadership and motivation through the instruction of Lifesaving Society Programs. You will also provide guarding and other additional water related courses. Working in a customer focused environment, you will be responsible for lesson planning and evaluation of program participants. You will contribute to a safe environment for staff and participants by educating all facility users on safe and enjoyable swimming practices, inspecting rescue equipment, and applying life support and first aid as required.

DUTIES

- Instruct learn-to-swim programs
- Assist with the supervision and organization of swimming pool activities
- Educate groups and individuals on the rules of the pool and enforce these rules
- Assist with the cleanliness of the facility and equipment as required
- Maintain adequate records including class progress reports, class attendance, test sheets and more, as required
- Endeavour at all times to work as a team with supervisors and fellow staff members
- Attend and actively participate in staff meetings and training

QUALIFICATIONS

- All applicants are to be a minimum of 16 years of age in accordance with Lifesaving Society standards.
- Life Saving Society Instructor or equivalent
- National Lifeguard Service (NLS)
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR Level C
- Police reference check with vulnerable sector screening prior to beginning employment
- Excellent customer service and interpersonal skills
- Automated External Defibrillator (AED) training would be considered an asset
- Waterfront certification would be considered an asset
- Written and oral French language skills would be considered an asset
- Experience teaching swimming classes would be considered an asset

COMPENSATION

Minimum wage as per the Employment Standards Act. This is a contract position that continues to June 2019. Availability for varying shifts including evenings and weekends is required.
