



Winter Patrol/Equipment Operator (SEASONAL CONTRACT POSITION)

The Town of Penetanguishene is a picturesque bilingual community with a population of approximately 9000 located on the southerly tip of beautiful Georgian Bay. We are currently seeking a Winter Patrol/Equipment Operator with a valid DZ Driver's Licence to join our Public Works Department for the 2019 to 2020 winter season.

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Operate a snowplow, sidewalk plow, front-end loader, sander and tandem truck to remove snow and ice from roads and sidewalks
- Repair asphalt and pave surfaces by hot-melt patching, chips and coal or masonry and cement work
- Perform minor maintenance tasks related to vehicles and equipment
- Under the direction of the Roads Supervisor, respond to complaints and requests for service from the public, other departments and Council

Required qualifications:

- Must hold a valid and unrestricted DZ Driver's Licence
- Excellent driving skills
- Ability to operate multiple but related pieces of equipment
- First Aid and CPR Certification would be considered an asset
- Chainsaw Licence would be an asset

Compensation:

The pay for this position is \$23.63 per hour plus 4% vacation pay. This is a temporary contract position that will run from November 2019 to April 2020.

Working conditions:

The employee is required to work evenings, nights, weekends and statutory holidays. The hours of work vary on a rotating schedule, 12:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m., for four days on and four days off. The successful candidates must be available on an on-call basis. The working environment for this position contains minimal risks or discomforts which require additional safety precautions. Conditions include frequent exposure to extreme temperatures.
