Youth Social Skills Programs

Social Skills Program Details

Has your child been diagnosed or is suspected of having ADHD, Autism, or a Developmental Concern? Does your child need help with expressive and receptive language skills, body language, personal space, social rules, building friendships, and more? If so then our Social Skills Group is here to help!

Social Skills Group is a 12-week group program divided into Part 1 and Part 2. Participants must register for both Part 1 and Part 2 separately.

The program coaches and promotes its participants to improve their social interactions and communication skills with others. A holistic and therapeutic play approach is used, guided by strength-based goals.

Each weekly session is 1 hour long, with a maximum of 6 participants in each age-based group with 1 facilitator. Each weekly session is structured with an icebreaker, specific topics and goals, engaging activities, crafts, and group discussions. This program also includes a workbook with weekly take-home summaries, caregiver resources, and visual aids.






