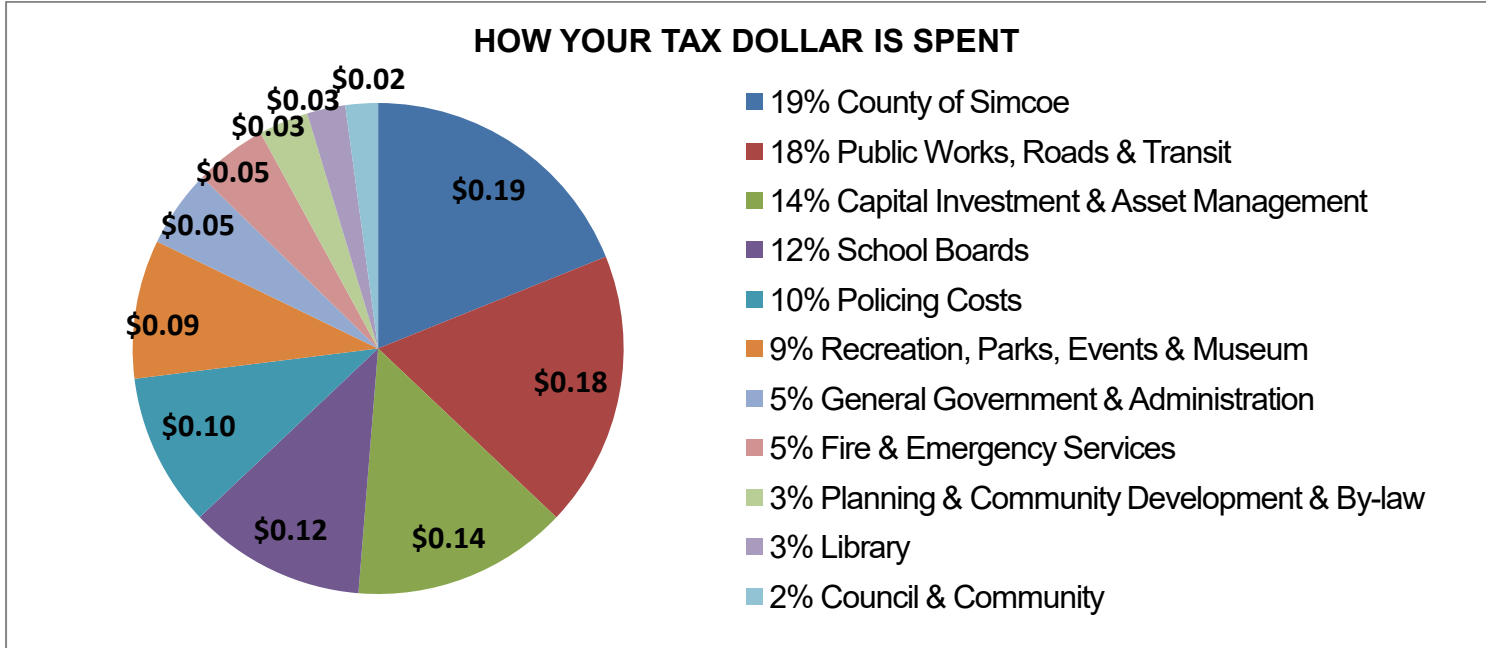
YOUR 2026 FINAL TAX BILL

The Town of Penetanguishene collects taxes on behalf of the Town (Operating & Capital), for OPP Policing costs, the County of Simcoe and the Province (Education).

Assessment Information

The Final Tax Bill is prepared in accordance with the 2026 Assessment Roll provided by MPAC (Municipal Property Assessment Corporation). In 2016, MPAC updated the assessed values for all properties in the Province of Ontario. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, MPAC postponed the provincial reassessment in 2020, and it has not yet been completed. The 2026 assessment is based on the 2016 assessment value that was phased in from 2017-2020, along with adjustments for building permit activity or reassessments by MPAC, if applicable. If there are any adjustments to assessment values that are not reflected on the Final Tax Bill, they will be processed as after-billing adjustments. Tax Payment Options

Mail – Cheques can be mailed to P.O. Box 5009, Penetanguishene, ON L9M 2G2. Please make cheques payable to the Town of Penetanguishene.

Drop Box – Cheques can be dropped off in the secure drop box located between the front doors of Townhall, at 10 Robert St. W. Do not place cash in the drop box. Please make cheques payable to the Town of Penetanguishene.

Post-Dated Cheques – Post-dated cheques will be held for deposit until the date indicated on the cheque.

Bank Payments (Telephone, Online, or In Person) – Pay by telephone, online or in-person banking through participating financial institutions using your Roll # (4372-xxx-xxxxxxx.0000) as the Account #. Enter all 19 digits only—no spaces, dashes, or periods. Search for “Penetanguishene Taxes” as the payee. To avoid late penalties, please allow 3-5 business days for electronic payments to be processed by your bank.

Pre-Authorized Payment (PAP) Plans – Available for tax accounts in good standing: Option 1 – Payments on installment due dates, or Option 2 – Twelve (12) monthly payments.

In Person – Payments can be made at Townhall, 10 Robert Street West, during office hours (8:30am – 4:30pm).

Online (Credit or Debit Card) – Payments can be made online by credit card or debit card (Visa or MasterCard) through the iCity Online Portal (*registration is required and third-party processing fees apply*).

Tax Receipts, Tax Bill Reprints, and Account Statements

Your Final Tax Bill reports the total annual property tax levy. **Please keep your final tax bill for income tax purposes.** There is a \$20.00 fee for tax receipts, tax bill reprints or account statements.
