Equipment Operator – 5 Month Contract Night Shift: 11:00pm – 7:30am Competition #2024-36

The Town of Penetanguishene is a picturesque bilingual community with a population of approximately 10,000, located on the southerly tip of beautiful Georgian Bay. As the Equipment Operator, you will operate equipment associated with road and sewer maintenance. This is a temporary, seasonal contract position from November 2024 to March 2025 covered under CUPE, Local 2308.05.

Duties include but are not limited to:

- Operates snowplows, sidewalk plow, front-end loader, and sander to remove snow and ice from roads and sidewalks.
- Operates a street sweeper, backhoe, shovel, pick, broom, truck, snow blower, bucket truck, hot-patch trailer, chipper, chain saw, power hand tools, sewer camera, locating tools, line marking equipment, rental equipment and various loaders and trackless attachments. Floating or transporting equipment when required.
- Rakes leaves, sweeps sidewalks, collects garbage, cuts grass and removes trees.
- Repairs asphalt and paves surfaces by hot-melt patching, chips and coal or masonry and cement work. Performs ditching and grading.
- Repairs and installs sanitary sewers, catch basins, and storm sewers. Conducts sewer locates, inspection, video camera inspections, maintenance, and repairs.
- Performs minor maintenance tasks related to vehicles and equipment (i.e. greasing, oiling, changing cutting edges on blades and changing light bulbs).
- Responds to complaints and requests for service from the public, Council and other Departments.
- Assists in developing Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) as required.
- Works with other Departments and Municipalities.
- Conducts road patrol.
- Conducts locates.
- Road maintenance activities.
- Other administrative duties as assigned by the Supervisor.

Required Qualifications:

- Secondary School completion.
- Must have a Class DZ Drivers Licence.
- Bilingualism (English & French) would be considered an asset.
- Ability to operate multiple but related pieces of equipment is a requirement.
- Chainsaw Cutters license would be considered an asset.
- Confined Space Entry Certificate would be considered an asset.
- Current First Aid/CPR Certificate would be considered an asset.
- Requires good computer skills including word processing/spreadsheet software, internet and email programs, and related office equipment.
- Must have excellent interpersonal skills.
- Must have excellent organizational, verbal and written communication skills.
- Must recognize when matters are confidential and exhibit discretion.
- Must have knowledge of Municipal policies and procedures.
- WHMIS Certification would be considered an asset.
- Knowledge of Occupational Health and Safety related legislation and practices is required.

Compensation: The current pay for this position is \$25.87 per hour plus 4% vacation pay, based on a 40-hour workweek.
